<u>Coach Credentials-</u> Per the Meet Information, these must have been pre-requested in OME. Any deck passes provided to a team beyond the amount requested in OME or beyond the limits per NE Swimming policy if approved will be charged \$35 per deck Contact Janelle at the NE office with any requests or questions.

Conduct of Meet- Prelims and Timed Finals

- All prelims/finals events shorter than 400 yards swum slowest to fastest- no flighting, no alternating
- 13-14 500 Freestyle and 400 Individual Medley- Fastest two heats of girls then boys circle seeded, remaining heats seeded fastest to slowest alternating girls/boys- <u>swimmers in the alternating heats must provide own timer</u>
- 11-12 500 Freestyle and 400 Individual Medley- Swum fastest to slowest, alternating girls/boys- all heats must provide own timer
- Thursday and Sunday Distance Freestyle- Fastest heat of girls 13-14, fastest heat of boys 13-14, fastest heat of girls 11-12, fastest heat of boys 11-12, then, remaining heats combined 11-14, seeded fastest to slowest, alternating girls/boys- <u>must provide own timer</u>

Conduct of Meet- Finals

- B-A Finals in that order, both heats are scoring
- A final will report to ready area (teaching pool) for parade, B final will report to blocks and will be announced in the water
- Athletes will exit the pool after each heat
- Alternates may only swim in B final, must be in start area ready to swim- we will not call for alternates

<u>Relays</u>

- Relay cards are due 30 minutes prior to estimated start of relays; changes may be made up to the time of the relay heat.
- Thursday's relays must provide own timer

Scratching From Finals- Prelim/Finals Events

- Any scratches from finals may only be made in-person with the Administrative Referee.
- Preliminary results will be read and swimmers will have 30 minutes to scratch or declare intention to scratch—see Administrative Referee
- Intent to scratch—Must confirm or void intent within 30 minutes after swimmer's last individual preliminary event of the day—if swimmer does not return, he/she will be seeded
- Refer to Meet Information for information on penalties

Tie Resolution

- Must resolve ties for 10th, 11th, 20th, 21st, 22nd
- MUST be resolved during prelims- there will be NO swim-offs before finals

Timelines

- Are estimates only—events may start earlier or later than published times
- Awards breaks are listed in timelines

Initial Splits

- Request form is available with Administrative Referee- please request BEFORE swim
- Return form after swim, please provide at least one stopwatch as backup (write stopwatch on form)
- Relay lead-off legs will be automatically loaded unless relay is disqualified

Time Trials

- Will be offered on Friday and Saturday ONLY
- Must already be entered in meet/added to meet by entry chair by Wednesday 2/19 and paid entry fees
- Deadline is 10:00 AM, or when filled to capacity
- Included in daily individual event limit
- Sign-up with Admin Referee on deck
- Time trials will begin approximately 10 minutes following the conclusion of prelims
- \$10 per individual event, \$40 per relay event- Venmo only

Warm-Ups/ Warm-Up Area

- Schedule posted on NE Swimming website
- No equipment permitted during warm-ups
- Sit-and-slide entry only- no diving except in designated areas/times

Hospitality

- Coaches and officials are asked to NOT leave bags/belongings at or near the timing table
